Dear Vendors/Booth Applicants:

It is that time of year when we are preparing to celebrate our New Kent County Fair. This year the fair will be held at New Kent Middle School, located at 7501 Egypt Road in New Kent on October 9th. You are cordially invited to participate in this fun-filled event and we look forward to your display of interesting items.

Space is very limited and only one space will be available per vendor. The deadline for vendor applications is September 30, 2021. Spaces outside are available, but you would have to provide your own tent. However, if we fill up our spaces early, we will close registration early. If we have available space after that day, we will offer additional spaces to vendors who wish to have them. Booth spaces are approximately 9' x 10' with some spaces 8' x 12' (outside spaces are actually larger—12' x 12'). The price for this year's booth space inside or outside is \$25.00, 8' table rental is \$10.00. For an additional \$5.00, we will list your business and create a link to it on our website. There are a limited number of booths which will have electricity available. If you request electricity you must provide an extension cord and tape to keep it in place.

The date of the 50th New Kent County Fair is Saturday, October 9th, from 10:00AM until 6:00PM. Set-up time will be Friday from 4 PM until 8PM or on Saturday from 7AM until 9:30AM. Please drive around back and enter the building—you will then be on the correct floor to set up. If you have an outside booth, you may unload out front, but please move your vehicle immediately. Please check with me to determine your exact location. We would greatly appreciate you cleaning up your area when taking down your booth and thank you in advance.
